

His object is to recall the life of the globe at its successive stages by founding on the same principles of structural affinity, function, and distribution that govern the present; and, combining past and present, to rise to the higher conception of the world s life-system, and the laws of causation by which it is sustained. In working out this important task, the palaeonto logist must exercise the greatest caution in establishing affinities and drawing analogies between the living and the extinct. He has to deal for the most part with fragments and disjointed organs, and in determining the relations of these he must ever remember that the past is replete with gradational forms that find in the present no immediate analogues. In the broader field of past life, not species and genera merely, but whole families, have become extinct, and in these forms the ordinal type is often so strangely modified that they present the widest departure from the existing families of the same order. The greatest blunders have been committed by losing sight of these facts. Detached organs have been assigned to positions they never occupied; functional analogies instituted where no analogy existed; and genera erected on fragments which, by subsequent discovery, were shown to belong to the...
